Old Testament: Creation & The Fall

OVERVIEW

When God created, He created something out of nothing, this is the Latin term *ex nihilo*. This is amazing! When our mind tries to wrap around this idea and how to understand the beginning, it can become difficult. Our minds are created within a finite, time- and space-dependent world, so we have to think within those boundaries. However, God created us *Imago Dei*, which means "in His image." This has huge implications, because this means we were created separate from all other creation, and God has specific purposes for creating us.
