The Son: Part One

## **OVERVIEW**

As we have discussed, the Trinity is a significant theology and is important for the Christian, because it enables us to experience God personally. The next person of the Trinity is the Son—this is Jesus. Jesus of Nazareth was a man born in the first century A.D. in Bethlehem, as prophesied. The Gospels—Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John—record the details of Jesus' life, because it changed the trajectory of history! This week, we will discuss the *historical significance* of the person of Jesus, then during the next session we will discuss the specific person of Jesus as the Son.
