### Read John 10

### As the Good Shepherd, Jesus guides us

### Read 10:3-4

- Why is it important for the sheep to know the voice of the Shepherd?
- What is the significance of Jesus naming every sheep?
- The Shepherd led the sheep. Are there areas in your life that Christ is excluded and not leading? (social, financial, family life, sexual life...) Do you give Him free reign to lead you wherever He wants?
- What can make it so challenging?

## As the Good Shepherd, Jesus provides for us

### Read John 10:7-9

- In the text above, Jesus changes the image from the Shepherd to being the gate. He says that all who enter through the gate will be saved. Saved from what?
- What is the result of entering and exiting the sheep fold through Jesus?
- Share examples from scripture that remind us of God's provision.

• What is Jesus referring to when he says he lays down his life for the sheep?
